A NEW CHALLENGE FOR SPACE LAW & BUSINESS - COMMERCIAL SPACE INFRASTRUCTURE SERVICES

Abstract

Recent emphasis on commercial solutions to space has resulted in new developments such as orbital or space infrastructure services.
