IAC2021 SPACE4ALL CHALLENGE

**Abstract**

As part of the 72nd International Astronautical Congress (IAC), which will be held in Paris from September 27th to October 1st, 2021. the French Space Agency (CNES), a French scientific and technical public industrial and commercial establishment, and UNOOSA (United Nations Office for Space Affairs - organization of the United Nations General Assembly responsible for matters related to space) have joined forces to launch an international competition aimed at involving higher education establishments and strengthening ties with them. Through this competition, CNES and UNOOSA offer these institutions the opportunity to get involved in artistic, media, technological, scientific, educational or other projects that they can propose (as a new project) or enrich (based on an existing project). A maximum of 5 winning establishments will be rewarded

The purpose of this presentation will be to describe the methods of participation but also the pre-selection processes in the identified geographic areas (Africa, North America, South America, Asia, Middle East, Oceania and Europe) and final selection during IAC 2021.
