CNES AND FRENCH RECENT RESULTS AND PERSPECTIVES IN DYNAMIC INTERNATIONAL  
HUMAN SPACEFLIGHT FRAMEWORK

**Abstract**

CNES like other space agencies being parties -now more than 20- of the International Space Exploration Coordination ISECG, regularly presents and provides insight on national community recent activities in Human Spaceflight and participates to the elaboration of the Global Exploration Roadmap GER which gives to the largest audience a shared direction and even more of future plans in the domain. Taking advantage of these considerations and of some current internal roadmapping developments, presentation will include indications on some recent French achievements, some newly decided participations and some perspectives, all to be conducted in international cooperation's schemes. These schemes have for frames the European Exploration Envelope Programme E3P of the European Space Agency ESA but also multiple direct cooperative agreements with international partners.
