Abstract

Governments and businesses around the world are interested in the opportunities and benefits that hu-

man space flight offers for inspiration and improving economies, and the lives of people on Earth. This paper offers a case study in how the Australian Space Agency is implementing its strategy to build Australia's space capabilities over the next ten years, with a focus on recent activities in Australia that can support human space flight.
