Abstract

The Australian Space Agency's purpose is to transform and grow a globally respected space industry that lifts the broader economy and inspires and improves the lives of Australians. The Australian Space Agency was established to provide a national focus to industry growth, and to create and sustain the conditions necessary to grow Australia's space sector. In April 2019, the Australian Space Agency unveiled Advancing Space: Australian Civil Space Strategy 2019-2029, which sets out a 10-year path to guide the growth of the space sector to A12billionandincreasethenumberofjobsinthesectorto30,000by2030.Thisstrategyidentified7Communicationstechnologiesandservices,RoboticsandautomationonEarthandin space, EarthObservation, PositionNavigationandTiming, and SpaceInfrastructure.
