### EGYPTIAN SPACE AGENCY CURRENT ACTIVITIES

#### **Abstract**

The Egyptian Space Agency was established in January 2018. According to the executive law no. 3 for the for 2018, The agency aims to create, transfer, localize, and develop space science and technology and possess the own capabilities to build satellites and launch them from the Egyptian lands in a manner that serves the country's strategy in the fields of development and achievement of the national security. The Agency is both legislative and executive body for space activities in Egypt. Current projects are carefully selected and planned to execute the national space program. The projects covers the six axes of the national space program which are capacity building, space systems, industrial development and infrastructure, space exploration, international cooperation, and legal and space standards. The present paper presents the current activities which include the executive technical and non-technical projects.
