Abstract

By offering smaller and more frequent launches, Astra is enabling access to Low Earth Orbit, with plans to deliver our first commercial payloads this summer. The vertically integrated manufacturing process in Astra's factory in the heart of Silicon Valley allows Astra to build rockets at scale, and enable customers to achieve rapid launch and replenishment of their constellations in LEO. This will enable a wave of innovation to improve life on Earth through greater connectivity and more regular observation.
